THE TRAIL

A GATEWAY TO HOUSTON'S GREENBELT

M-K-T is named after the historic Missouri-Kansas-Texas M-K-T railroad line. This abandoned rail line was transformed into the vibrant M-K-T Heights Hike and Bike Trail that outlines the project's 3-acre linear park.

The M-K-T Heights Hike and Bike Trail links 50 miles of greenways and trails and connects the Heights to downtown Houston and nearby neighborhoods. The hike and bike trail is the main artery of the property connecting the site with its top-user demographic and daily neighborhood visitors.



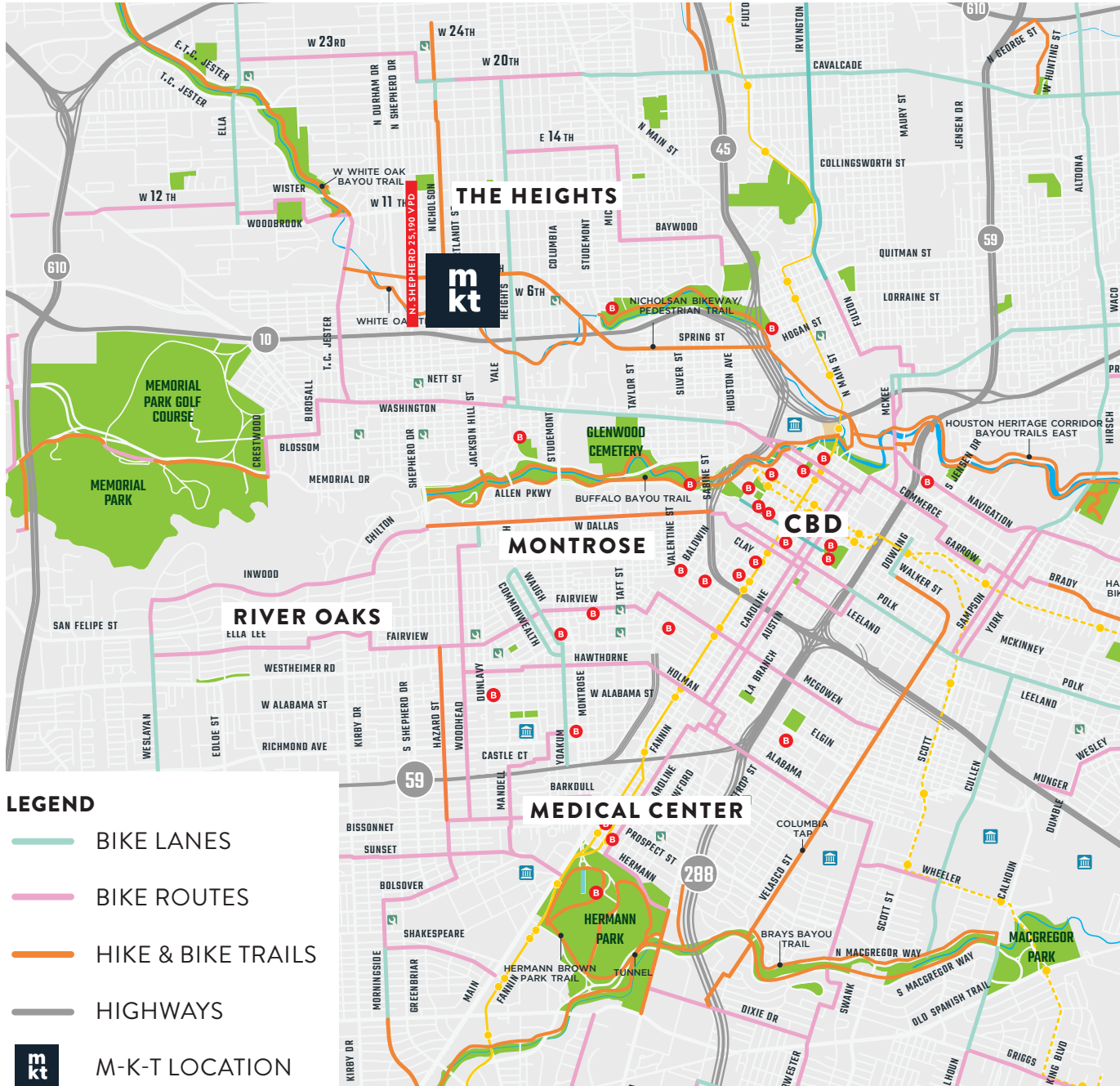


THE NEIGHBORHOOD
